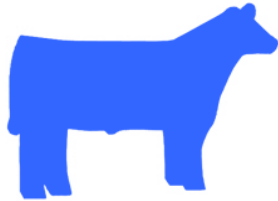

- Showmanship will be First Show - Exhibitors are required to compete in Showmanship
- All animals must be in place by 9:00 am
- Must meet all health requirements - Necessary health papers must be presented upon arrival at the fairgrounds.
- Purebred beef must furnish registration papers or be shown in commercial class.
- Must furnish own bedding and feed.
- Exhibitor must remove bedding, etc. immediately after show as directed by the Superintendents
