



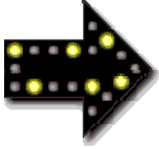

Activities involved in the Youth Expo will include being around and working with animals and people. Attending the Youth Expo may lead to contact with individuals who are experienced and inexperienced in the above mentioned activities. I also understand that participation in this activity is strictly voluntary and is not a requirement for 4-H or FFA membership.

I am aware and have discussed with my child that:

1. Being in and around animals, fences, buildings, fairground facilities and other people may cause clothing to become wet, dirty and beyond cleaning and/or repair;
2. Working with animals may give rise to risk of injury arising from the surface or subsurface of the ground, show ring and barn on/in which showing occurs;
3. Other participants may act in a negligent manner which otherwise may result in harm to my child;
4. Showing an animal may lead to injury caused by any number of things, contact with other animals or show people and/or objects in the show ring and barn area.
5. While participating in the Youth Expo youth may risk injury from the very nature of learning new skills.

I recognize that the above outlined activities and potential resulting risk may cause injury, death, or loss to participants or other persons in the immediate vicinity.

I understand that my child is not required to participate in these activities, but grant permission for him/her to do so, despite the possible risks. I recognize that by participating in this activity, as with any physical activity, my child may risk personal injury. I hereby attest and verify that I have been advised of the potential risks, that I have full knowledge of the risks involved in this activity, and that I assume any expenses that may be incurred in the event of an accident, illness or other incapacity, regardless of whether I have authorized such expenses.

BEEF CATTLE CLASSES – Superintendent, Tommy Puffenburger

Section A – Fitting & Showing

- Class 1...Senior Showmanship, 14 years & up as of January 1, 2008
- Class 2...Junior Showmanship, 13 years & younger as of January 1, 2008
- Class 3...Overall Champion from class 1 and 2
- Class 4...Reserve Overall Champion from class 1 and 2

Section B - Breeding Cattle - Registered & Commercial

- Shown by the following breeds: Angus, Polled and Horned Hereford, Limousin, Shorthorn, Simmental, etc. & Commercial
- Class 1... Junior heifer calves - Born after January 1, 2008
 - Class 2... Senior heifer calves, born between July 1 and December 31, 2007
 - Class 3... Junior yearling heifers, born between January 1 and June 30, 2007
 - Class 4... Overall Female Champion - All Breeds
 - Class 5... Overall Reserve Female Champion - All Breeds

Section C - FFA & 4-H Feeder Steers

- These must be steers being prepared for the local County Fairs. All FFA and 4-H youth are encouraged to participate.
- Class 1...Feeder Steers - May be divided.
 - Class 2...Champion Feeder Steer
 - Class 3...Reserve Champion Feeder Steer

GOAT CLASSES – Superintendent, Beverly Yebernetsky

Section A – Fitting & Showing

- All showmen are encouraged to participate & use these classes as a learning experience
- Class 1...Senior Showmanship, 14 years & up as of January 1, 2008
 - Class 2...Junior Showmanship, 13 years & younger as of January 1, 2008
 - Class 3...Overall Champion from class 1 and 2
 - Class 4...Reserve Overall Champion from class 1 and 2

Section B – Kids & Does

- Animals will be shown by the following breeds: Non-Dairy Breeding Stock, Pygmy, Boer, and Boer X Meat goats
- Class 1...Jr. Kid born on or after April 1, 2008
 - Class 2...Sr. Kid born January 1 to March 31, 2008
 - Class 3...Yearling born 2007 - 1 year, and under 2 years as of June 7, 2008
 - Class 4...Overall Grand Champion-All Breeds
 - Class 5... Overall Reserve Grand Champion-All Breeds

Section C- Feeder Goats (Meat breeds, no pygmy)

- Class 1...Market Goats - May be divided
- Class 2...Grand Champion Market Goat
- Class 3...Reserve Champion Market Goat

SHEEP CLASSES - Superintendent, Joy Shreck

Section A – Fitting & Showing

- Class 1...Senior Showmanship, 14 years & up as of January 1, 2008
- Class 2...Junior Showmanship, 13 years & younger as of January 1, 2008
- Class 3...Overall Champion from class 1 and 2
- Class 4...Reserve Overall Champion from class 1 and 2

Section B - Breeding Sheep: Purebreds & Crossbreds of all breeds

- Class 1...Ewe Lamb - January 1, 2008 to May 23, 2008
- Class 2...Fall Ewe Lamb - September 1 – December 31, 2007
- Class 3...Yearling Ewe – January 1, 2007 to August 31, 2007
- Class 4...Overall Champion Ewe (All Breeds)
- Class 5...Overall Reserve Champion Ewe (All Breeds)

Section C - Feeder Lambs

- Must meet tail docking policy for West Virginia Lambs, have a USDA Scrapie Tag & not weigh more than 100 lbs at BCFB Expo.
- Class 1...Feeder Lamb Class
 - Class 2...Overall Champion Feeder Lamb
 - Class 3...Overall Reserve Champion Feeder Lamb
